ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES

The university takes pride in offering three comprehensive law programs designed to cater to students at different stages of their legal education journey. These programs are carefully structured to provide both theoretical knowledge and practical skills essential for success in the legal profession. Each course maintains high academic standards while ensuring students receive personalized attention and mentorship from experienced faculty members.

BA.LL.B. (Hons.)

The five-year integrated BA.LL.B. (Hons.) program represents a synthesis of liberal arts education and comprehensive legal training. This undergraduate curriculum encompasses foundational areas including constitutional jurisprudence, criminal law, civil procedures, and corporate governance. Students engage in experiential learning through moot court advocacy, legal aid initiatives, and structured internships with premier judicial and corporate institutions. The pedagogical approach emphasizes comparative legal analysis, incorporating both domestic and international legal frameworks to enhance global competency and career versatility.

B.B.A.LL.B. (Hons.)

The BBA LLB program is designed to bridge business acumen and legal expertise. Blending core business with legal disciplines, students explore subjects like Management Information Systems, Data Analytics for Decision Making, Introduction to Artificial Intelligence, Management Accounting, and Principles of Human Resource Management. This course also incorporates Managerial Economics, Ethics, and Business Communication. The course equips students with the analytical and Business communication skills essential for navigating the business world and the legal landscape, aiming to foster the next generation of entrepreneurs and leaders in a rapidly growing economy.

LL.M. - Master of Laws (One Year)

The one-year LL.M. program offers specialized postgraduate education across diverse legal disciplines, including corporate law, intellectual property rights, environmental law, and mediation. This intensive curriculum combines advanced theoretical study with practical application through research seminars, case analyses, and collaborative workshops. Faculty mentorship and comprehensive library resources support scholarly inquiry and professional development.



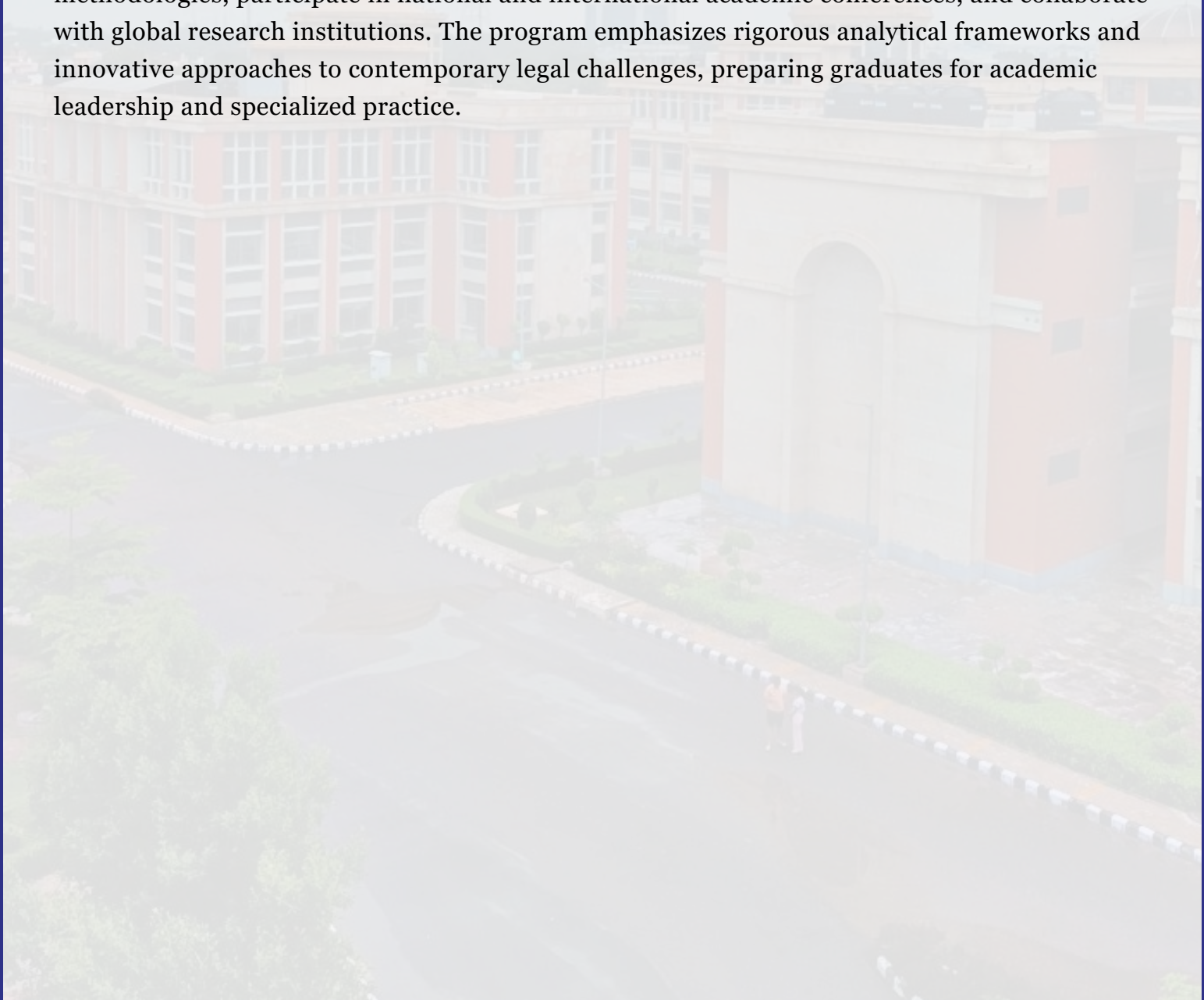
ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES

LL.M. - Master of Laws (Two Year)

The two-year LL.M. program represents the institution's premier postgraduate offering, distinguished by its comprehensive scope and research intensity. This extended curriculum allows for deeper specialization, advanced dissertation work, and extensive clinical experience. Students benefit from enhanced industry partnerships, international exchange opportunities, and mentorship from leading legal practitioners and scholars.

Ph.D. - Doctor of Philosophy in Law

The doctoral program serves as the apex of legal scholarship, designed for candidates pursuing original research contributions to legal knowledge. Doctoral scholars engage in interdisciplinary methodologies, participate in national and international academic conferences, and collaborate with global research institutions. The program emphasizes rigorous analytical frameworks and innovative approaches to contemporary legal challenges, preparing graduates for academic leadership and specialized practice.



B.B.A.LL.B. (Hons.) Programme

The five year integrated BBA LLB program offers dynamic coursework, where students learn master data-driven decision-making with analytics and AI fundamentals, honing strategic thinking for complex business challenges. This programme prepares students for leadership prowess via human resource management and managerial economics, while sharpening their ethical judgment and negotiation skills essential for corporate success. Students are trained to Excel in business communication and cultivate entrepreneurial vision to innovate and lead. With a strong focus on real world simulations, moot courts and industry immersion, students will gain both courtroom confidence and boardroom competence

Core Objectives:

- To foster entrepreneurial mindset and leadership through human resource management and business communication
- To develop legally sound, ethically grounded, and strategically skilled professionals.
- To build versatile professionals who can navigate corporate law firms, judiciary services, startups, public policy, and global institutions with equal ease.
- This programme is designed not just to produce lawyers, but to shape future legal leaders.

Admission Procedure

The Admission is based on the merit through the Common Law Admission Test (CLAT). However, to qualify for admission:

- The candidate must have passed 10+2 examination of the Board of School Education, Haryana or its equivalent State/Central Board with minimum 45% marks in the aggregate (40% marks for SC/ST candidates)

OR

- The candidate must have passed 10th with two-year diploma course or one year diploma course with one year apprenticeship from the ITIs recognized by the Skill Development & Industrial Training Institutes Department, Haryana, with Hindi or English as an additional subject from the Haryana Board of School Education, Bhiwani.
- The candidates appeared in the qualifying examination held in 2026 may apply provisionally, subject to the condition that they shall produce the proof of having passed the qualifying examination with the prescribed percentage of marks and other requisite documents at the time of their counselling for admission at DBRANLU, Sonapat.

The candidature of:

- Those who do not clear the qualifying examination with the requisite marks and or fail to produce the result on the date of counselling,

OR

- Those who get compartments/re-appear in any subject in the qualifying examination shall be cancelled and subsequent securing qualifying marks shall not be considered in any case. A candidate applying in any type of reserved category is required to submit a category certificate issued by the competent authority on the date and time of counselling.

Intake and Reservation

The total sanctioned intake for the B.B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) Five-Year Integrated Course is Sixty (60). Tentative division of the seats shall be as under:

(i) On non-availability of eligible ST candidate, the seat shall be converted into the SC Category.

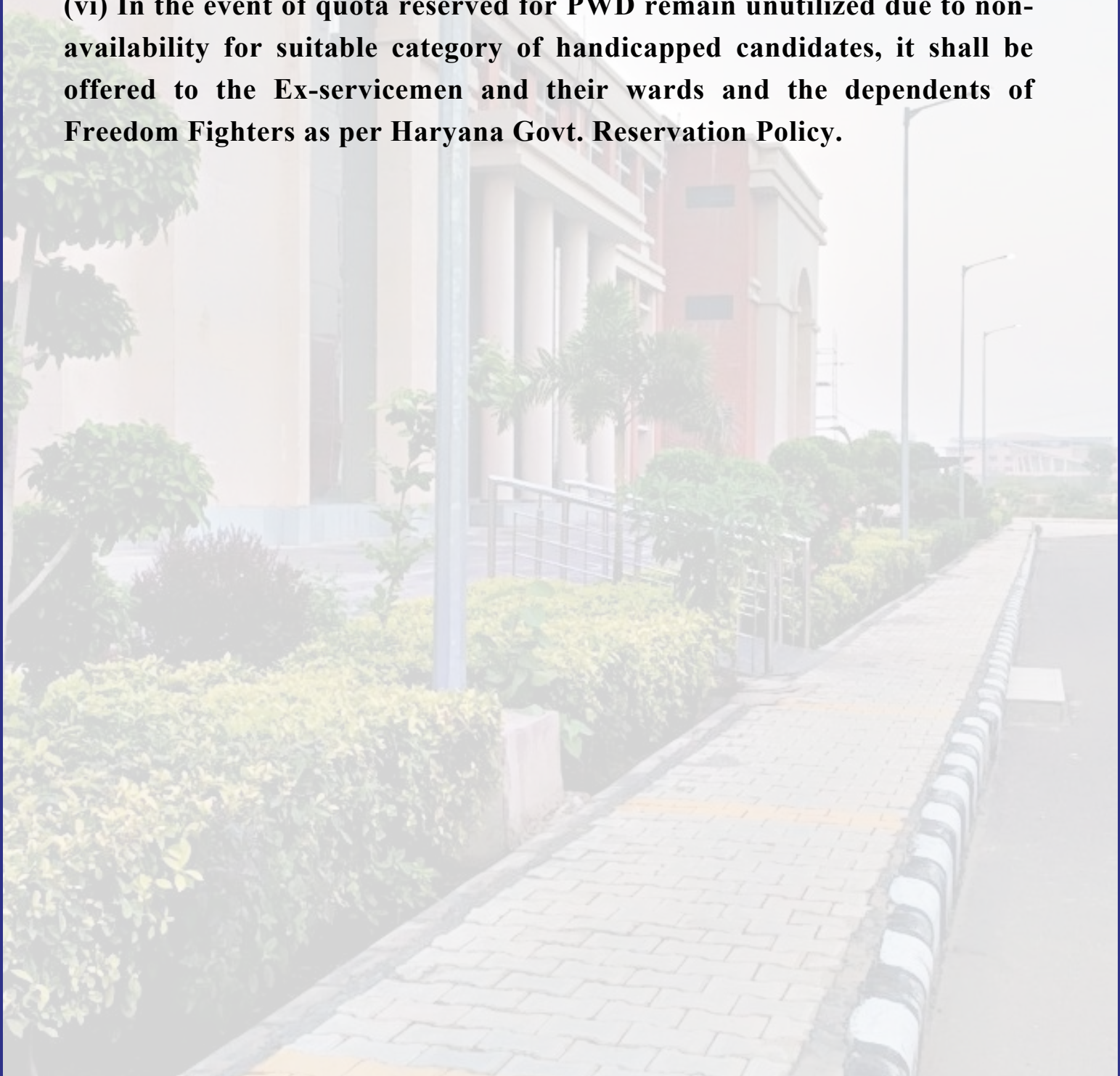
(ii) On non availability of eligible SC candidate, the seat shall be converted into DSC Category

(iii) On non availability of eligible DSC candidate, the seat shall be converted into SC Category

(iv) On non-availability of eligible EWS Category candidate, the seat shall be converted into the General Category.

(v) On non-availability of eligible WLRGEC category candidates, the seat shall be converted and filled from the eligible candidates of NRI-Haryana category. Further, non-availability of eligible candidates in the NRI-Haryana Category, the seat shall be converted and filled from the eligible candidates of Unreserved-Haryana category.

(vi) In the event of quota reserved for PWD remain unutilized due to non-availability for suitable category of handicapped candidates, it shall be offered to the Ex-servicemen and their wards and the dependents of Freedom Fighters as per Haryana Govt. Reservation Policy.

HOSTELS

Established in July 2019, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar National Law University operates from its main campus in Sonapat, Haryana, offering mandatory residential facilities in 8-floor Boys' and Girls' Hostels. These are under the overall supervision of the Chief Warden, assisted by Wardens and Hostel Supervisors. The hostels are equipped with lifts, purified drinking water, power backup, and Wi-Fi. Furnished rooms, hygienic mess and dining facilities, security, and recreational amenities ensure a safe, inclusive, and comfortable environment conducive to academic pursuits.

LIBRARY

Dr. B.R. Ambedkar National Law University offers a spacious, air-conditioned library with ample seating and modern facilities. The fully computerized, Wi-Fi-enabled DBRANLU Knowledge Resource Centre subscribes to premier e-resources like Manupatra, Westlaw, JSTOR, Lexis-Nexis, EBC Reader, and Live Law. The university also publishes the DBRANLU Law Review, a peer-reviewed biannual journal dedicated to advancing legal scholarship and promoting intellectual discourse through high-quality research addressing contemporary legal issues, theories, and developments across diverse domains of law.

RESEARCH CENTRES
