- 2) Candidates are advised to satisfy themselves before applying that they possess all the minimum essential qualifications laid down for the post advertised in this advertisement.
- While filling the academic details, if marks are given in form of the CGPA then a conversion formula to convert CGPA into percentage along-with such conversion, as issued by the Competent Authority awarding the CGPA, should be provided by the applicant.

 In case marks are given in form of the CGPA along-with conversion formula as well as absolute marks, then to compute the percentage, CGPA will be used. In case marks are given in form of the CGPA but conversion formula is not provided by the candidate then CGPA shall be multiplied by default value 9 on a
- 4) To compute the merit points, no rounding off shall be carried out. The number should be corrected up to three decimal places.
- 5) In case of integrated program, the percentage marks shall be considered for both the degrees covered under the program (i.e. graduation and post-graduation) as the percentage marks of the integrated program.
- 6) In case of lateral entry programs, percentage marks given in the degree of awarding university will be considered final.
- 7) The eligibility of every candidate will be determined on the basis of qualifications acquired and communicated to the Univ. by him/her up to the last date fixed for submission of the applications in this advertisement. No certificate/document will be accepted/considered after the last date of submission of application.
- 8) The scores (based on data filled in by the Candidate and evaluated by the Scrutiny Committee) shall be shared with the applicant. In case there is any discrepancy, candidate can represent the same to the University within seven days of the Notification, or as per instruction that will be shared with the candidate.
- 9) Candidates who were registered for Ph.D. Programme prior to July 11, 2009 and were awarded degree later on, are required to submit certificate for fulfillment of the conditions as per UGC Regulations applicable on the same. - The benefit of reservation will be given only to those SC/BCA/BCB/ESM/PWD/ EWS/ESP candidates who are domiciled of Haryana State. These candidates are required to submit self-attested photocopy of SC/BCA/BCB /ESM/PwBD /EWS /ESP Certificate duly issued by the Competent Authority of Haryana. Likewise, the Eligible Sports Persons (ESP) are required to submit self-attested photocopy of the Sports Gradation Certificate duly issued by the Competent Authority. ESM/DESM/DFF(s) are required to submit self-attested photocopy of the Valid Eligibility Certificate duly issued by the respective Zila Sainik Board. EWS (Economically Weaker Section) candidates are required to submit self-attested photocopy of Certificate as per instructions of the Haryana Government.

- The Ex-Serviceman who had not availed the benefit of ESM in re-employment in any govt, service / Public Sector Undertaking, including Para Military Forces, their dependents sons and daughters will be considered for appointment(s) against the posts reserved for Ex-Servicemen to the extent of non-availability of suitable Ex-Servicemen candidate, provided that they fulfill all the other required conditions viz. qualifications, age, experience etc. This entitlement would be available to one dependent child only. - 16) The benefit of reservation to Ex-Servicemen and their children will be given in accordance with the instructions of the of the Govt. of Haryana, as conveyed vide its Notification No. 12/15/2019-4GS-II dated 14.07.2021.
- 17) Backward class Block (A & B) candidates claiming benefit of reservation will have to submit self-attested photocopy of a certificate issued by the Competent Authority of Haryana. This certificate must not have been issued six months before the last date of receipt of applications. Also, there must be mention in the certificate that that the candidate is not covered under the criteria of creamy layer as per State Govt. instructions issued by vide letter No. 1170- SW(1)-95 dated 07.06.1995 & No. 213-SW(1)-2010 dated 31.08.2010, No.22/22/2004 3GS-III dated 14.06.2016, No.1282- SW(1) dated 28.08.2018 and No. 512-SW (1) 2021 dated 01.12.2021. Kindly refer Annexure-IV titled "Backward Class Certificate (BLOCK 'A' or 'B' for this purpose.
- 18) Contact details of the candidates:
 - i. Kindly mention valid & active email ID and mobile no. in the application form;
 - ii. All communication from the Univ. will be done on the email ID & or the mobile no. mentioned in the application form;
 - iii. In case, incomplete / incorrect information is mentioned therein the application, candidate himself/herself shall be liable; and, no further request shall be entertained in this regard.
- 19) All the educational qualifications should be from a University/ Institution/ Board recognized by Govt. of India/State Govt./ approved by Govt. Regulatory Bodies and the final result should have been declared on or before the last date of submission of application form. The candidates who are able to prove through documentary evidence that the result of the qualifying examination was declared on or before the last date of submission of application form and he/she has been declared passed, will also be considered to have the required Educational Qualification.
- 20) The date of passing eligibility examination will be considered the date appearing on the mark sheet or provisional certificate issued by the respective University. In case, the result of a particular examination is posted on the website of the University, a certificate issued by competent authority of the University indicating the date on which the result was posted on the website will be considered as the date of passing the respective degree.
- As per Ministry of Human Resource Development Notification No. 44 dated 01-03-1995 published in Gazette of India edition dated 10-06-2015, the Degree obtained through Open Universities/ Distance Education Mode needs to be recognized by Distance Education Council, IGNOU (Now Distance Education Bureau). Accordingly, unless such Degrees had been recognized for the period when the candidates acquired the relevant qualification, these will not be accepted for the purpose of Educational Qualification.
- 22) No change in the category of any candidate is allowed after submission of application form. No correspondence/email/ phone will be entertained in this regard.
- 23) The status of short-listing of candidates will be made available on the website of Dr. B.R.A.N.L.U., Sonepat. In case of any dispute with regard to screening of the applications, the decision of the University shall be final.
- 24) No TA/DA will be paid by the University for physical presence in the university for consideration in the selection process.
- 25) Candidate who is already employed shall have to apply through 'proper channel' and has to submit the "No Objection Certificate" signed by his/her employer as per Annex. V. Those not applying through proper channels will not be considered for any benefit of past employment, if selected.
- 26) For calculation of API score, candidates must attach the first page of all publications listed in the application, failing which such publications will not be considered for given purpose. Further, given candidate may not be called for interview due to lack of the minimum API score as per the norms. Candidates are required to bring original copies of all publications at the time of interview.

- 27) Candidate must attach documents in support of any claim, like, 'peer reviewed journal', 'impact factor of a journal', 'authorship', etc. failing which points will not be allotted as per the claim. Scrutiny Committee will allot marks in given case as per documents attached with the application. Any request / claim in this regard, at any stage of the selection process, will not be considered.
- 28) The entire onus of the content/authenticity of the information in the application form and its attachments shall exclusively rest with the applicant.
- Mere submission of application form does not mean that the candidate is eligible for appointment to the post applied for. The eligibility shall be verified at the time of verification of original documents as per the qualifications, and terms & conditions for the given posts. If at any stage, it is found that the information furnished by the candidate is fake, incorrect, or incomplete, the candidature shall be cancelled, and the candidate will also be liable to legal proceedings.
- 30) The University shall not be responsible for any error/ omission/ commission/ suppression of relevant information—by the applicant knowingly/ unknowingly/ overtly/ covertly while filling up the application form and the—documents required therein. Candidates must ensure that they fulfill all the eligibility conditions on the last date—fixed for receipt of application. - 31) In case the applicant gets screened/ shortlisted/ selected/ appointed based on the credentials furnished by applicant which are, on scrutiny, found to be incorrect/ inadmissible/ forged/ fabricated/ falsified, applicant's candidature shall be liable to be cancelled at any stage of the recruitment/at any time during the tenure of the service and appropriate legal action under applicable law shall be initiated against the applicant. The University may verify the antecedents or documents submitted by the candidate at any time during tenure of the service. In case, if it is detected that the documents submitted by the candidates are fake or the candidate has suppressed the information, then his/her services shall be terminated.

- 33) The possession of prescribed essential qualification does not entitle a candidate to be called for an interview.
